

## Holy Family Parish Council Meeting Minutes – November 22, 2021

**Attendees:** Deacon Pat Wright, Jackie Mudd (Chairperson), Helen Arnold, Jim Gast, Michele Osbourn and Becky Morris. **Absent:** Fr. George Munjanattu, Randy Thomas.

Deacon Pat opened the meeting at 7:00 p.m. with a prayer.

1. New sign on the front of the property is in progress. Mary Beth Porter researching a deed for the church/Archdiocesan properties to determine number of signs allowed on front of property. May require a survey.
2. A piece of property was gifted to Holy Family from Teresa Becker at 1214 Becker Avenue off Preston, south of Gilmore Lane. A neighbor desires to purchase the property. **ACTION ITEM:** Deacon Pat has attempted to reach the interested neighbor to determine viability to sell. If she cannot be reached, he may contact other neighbors and/or turn over to realtor.
3. Church repairs – Don Wissell (primary) and Mike Jefferson looking into new handrails for the ramp by the baptismal font and the cantor’s stand. Don is working on pricing, design and material availability. Work is expected to complete in 2-3 weeks.
4. Update on music and the choir – Additional instrumental music books have been ordered. Choir member masks have been ordered. Four new choir members and one new cantor have contacted Rachel. **ACTION ITEM:** Jackie to check with Rachel Booker about placing a survey at the end of the pews about any interest in the choir and other music related items.
5. Stewardship Form – Jackie Mudd stated that 55 Stewardship forms have been returned. **ACTION ITEM:** It was suggested that blank forms be available in church for anyone who misplaced theirs or others interested in being active.
6. Saffin Center kitchen has had an update. The old dishwasher was removed and a new, long stainless sink and counter have been placed to upgrade the dishwashing area.
7. Other discussion:
  - Deacon Pat to update parish project list. **ACTION ITEM:** Deacon Pat will give updated project list to Fr. George and Mike Jefferson. Parish Council will review in the next meeting.
  - Security cameras around campus – estimates from 3 vendors are in process.
  - Deacon Pat to get with a contact to make recommendations on setting up a Safety team in the parish. **ACTION ITEM:** Deacon Pat to check with another deacon on information about Safety Teams in other parishes.
  - Children’s Christmas program 12/19 at 3 p.m. in the church.
  - Advent Retreat scheduled for four Monday evenings from 6 – 7:30 in the Brennan room.

- Michele Osbourn reported there were 15 attendees to the Narcan training class. Michelle plans to get Narcan certified. Community Health Ministry will then consider offering a CPR/Narcan class.
- Summer picnic currently planned for June 24-25.

- Feast of the Holy Family will be celebrated Sunday January 2<sup>nd</sup> following 10 a.m. Mass.
