Old Business

- New church signage remains on hold
 - o A location change is being considered, to be compliant with City of Louisville Zoning
 - Old school signage is being removed
 - o The current church sign (faces east vs. north/south) will be removed
- A vacant lot (1214 BECKER AVE) was found to be owned by Holy Family Parish since 1953
 - o Pat will work to have the property listed by a realtor for sale
- Social Club Fish Frys will begin Friday, February 25th, running through April 8, 2022
 - o Fish Fry committee members have met
 - Fish Frys will include in-house dining and drive thru pick-up
- Parish project list from Father George and Deacon Pat was reviewed
 - Priority for new wheels and number boards for festivals, has been increased, to be available for use at the 2022 summer picnic (approximately \$5000-\$8000)
 - Quotes are being collected for new awnings (total of 6: 4 for the church, 2 for the chapel)
 - Purchase of a second camera for live-streaming mass added to the list
 - o Explore the repair and restoration of the fountain in rear foyer of the church added to the list
 - Update/replace the steeple bell system for the church added to the list
