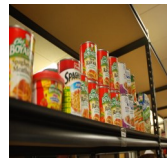

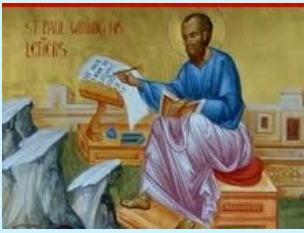

MASS READING EXPLAINED—THE LETTERS OF ST PAUL

Starting Sunday September 10, after the 10am Mass you are invited to an enrichment program in the Chapel. The

discussion will focus on the second reading for each Sunday using a series hosted by Dr Brant Pitre. The videos are about 20 minutes and we will have a short discussion following the video. During Sundays in Ordinary time the second reading is on its own independent 3-year cycle for Romans, Ephesians, Galatians. The selected readings in our lectionary focus on the moral life and the spiritual life. Most of us are comfortable with Jesus, and with Peter but may find Paul challenging. Walk with us on this journey and discover the richness of his testimony. Learn how Paul invites us to abandon old ways of living and embrace a new life in Christ.

Inter-parish Family Faith Formation, or IFFF, consists of a group of Catholic families with school aged children that do not attend a Catholic grade school, but want their children to learn and grow in the Catholic faith, as well as receive their sacraments. Family faith formation classes are offered to children in kindergarten through 8th grade. We also provide First Communion and Confirmation preparation. Sessions meet the third Sunday of the month from 11:00am-1:00pm. Faith formation materials for other weeks are provided. At least one parent/guardian is required to attend with their child/ren.

The IFFF leadership team will offer sessions September 2023 through May of 2024. The first meeting is scheduled for Sunday September 17, from 11am – 1pm, at St. Stephen Martyr parish. 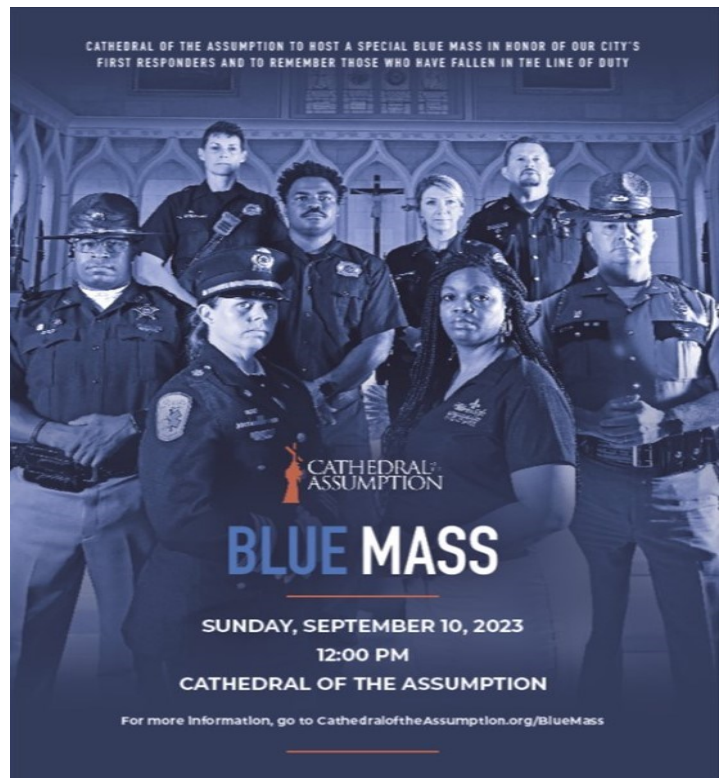
